

GTR 373: Front Range Forest Restoration Field Workshop

Front Range land managers and scientists generally agree on the need for restoration of ponderosa pine and dry mixed-conifer forests. Until now, much of the information guiding this restoration on the Front Range has come from other areas of the western U.S.

General Technical Report 373 (GTR 373), *Principles and Practices for the Restoration of Ponderosa Pine and Dry Mixed-Conifer Forests of the Colorado Front Range* provides managers with place-based restoration solutions that incorporate local ecology and processes.
