POSITION: Schools and Outdoor Learning Environments (SOLE) Spring Educator

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Schools and Outdoor Learning Environments (SOLE) is a program that connects 4th grade classrooms across Colorado and their families to the outdoors. This position focuses on scheduling SOLE in-class programs, including teaching and coordinating these programs. This position offers professional development and job shadowing opportunities. The SOLE Educator will be responsible for:

- Presenting and leading education programs in the classroom, at state parks, and for SOLE families.
- Using Colorado Academic Standards to build SOLE's environmental education in-class programs and resources for teachers.
- Working with teachers to assist in the scheduling of field trips at state parks.
- Providing excellent customer service to internal and external partners of SOLE.
- Assisting in additional aspects of program implementation as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor's degree in education, biology, environmental studies, wildlife, natural resources, recreation, history, or related field.
- Strong teamwork, communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Experience educating or working with K-12 students.
- Excellent organizational and writing skills.
