The City has hired topic expert professionals to lead the City through a public process and a plan update.

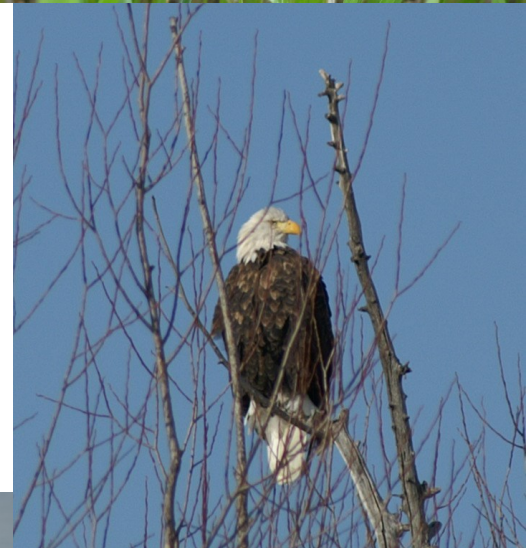
