

SPLT Development and Communications Director May 13, 2020

The Southern Plains Land Trust (SPLT) seeks an experienced and high-energy professional with a passion for wildlife and habitat protection to direct development and communications. This position is vital to our mission to create and protect a network of shortgrass prairie preserves, which ensure a future for all native animals and plants.

SPLT has expanded from 3,300 acres protected a decade ago to more than 32,000 acres protected today. We seek a Development and Communications Director to maintain this momentum. This employee will report to the Executive Director. The position entails telecommuting from a home office preferably based in the greater Denver area or southeast Colorado, with regular travel to SPLT's beautiful prairie preserves in southeast Colorado.

# **Principal Responsibilities**

Working closely with the Executive Director, the Development and Communications Director will:

- Recruit and retain individual and corporate donors through digital and postal appeals, fundraising events (both in-person and virtual), and direct donor communications
- Raise funds from charitable foundations, through letters of inquiry, grant proposals, grant reports, and researching additional funding opportunities
- Raise revenue through entrepreneurial sources
- Track financials for SPLT from all of these sources
- Manage all marketing and communications, including high-quality printed materials, website, annual report, social media, and blog
- Create an annual development and communications plan and work with staff, board, and volunteers to implement
- Supervise select interns and volunteers to expand the organization's capacity

## **Position Requirements**

Qualified candidates must have:

- A passion for preserving wildlife and natural habitats
- A Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field
