Special requirements:

- *Must be in good physical condition, able to hike moderate to difficult trails
- *Hold current First Aid/CPR Certification (a class will be offered prior to camp)
- *Must have transportation to and from drop-off/pick-up locations
- *Applicants must be 18 years of age
- *Must submit to required background checks

*Must have 3/mos. full-time or equivalent (460 hours) verifiable experience working with children, or hold a degree in elementary, early childhood, or environmental education.
