This is a full-time, twelve (12) month, non-tenure track faculty position on the Extension instructor track (instructor, senior, master) or the Extension professor track (assistant, associate, professor) dependent upon the candidate's academic credentials and professional experience. The faculty appointment, evaluation, and promotion standards are centered around the three core duties of extension faculty – educate, create, and connect. Candidates are sought with interests that complement and expand upon current initiatives and education activities in OEE.

Colorado State University Extension and Boulder County are seeking an agriculture professional with the experience and skills to lead a diverse and inclusive agriculture program. The person will have a proven track record of successful teaching and evaluation, creating innovative programming opportunities for diverse constituents, public speaking, providing technical consultation, building program capacity through grants and contracts, and fostering both internal and external collaboration and teamwork. The Extension Specialist will be an effective communicator with the experience and skills to engage with a variety of people and groups, including the Boulder County Commissioners and other policymakers in Boulder County government. The individual in this position works as a member of the Boulder County Extension team and as a local representative of Colorado State University.

The primary office location for this position is in Longmont, CO while this position is eligible for a hybrid work arrangement, the individual is expected to maintain a balance establishing a presence in the primary office, to effectively carry out the duties of the position. The work schedule will vary, and occasional nights and weekends will be required.
