Eligibility

Program participation will require 15-30 hours (2-4 hours/month) to attend meetings and complete work for the program from Sep 2024-April 2025. Community organization participants who complete the program may receive an honorarium of up to \$800 to help support their time investment in the program and their ongoing climate resilience efforts.

We seek 10 representatives from community organizations in Northern Colorado to participate in the CLImates cohort.

An honorarium of up to \$800 may be provided.
