

Community Organizations— join us in the coming year!

The COOLER Climate Leadership Institute program (COOLER-CLimates) aims to build a community where local organizations in Northern Colorado and University of Northern Colorado (UNCO) students and faculty **learn together, support each other, and collaborate on projects** to help address **climate change resilience in the region.**

Eligibility

Applicant represents a mission-driven community organization, group, or project in Northern Colorado that is involved or interested in climate change resilience activities and has a passion for working with the broader community and university students & faculty on climate change issues.

Time commitment

Program participation will require 15-30 hours (2-4 hours/month) to attend meetings and complete work for the program from Sep 2024-April 2025. Community organization participants who complete the program may receive an honorarium of up to \$800 to help support their time investment in the program and their ongoing climate resilience efforts.

We seek **10 representatives from community organizations in Northern Colorado** to participate in the CLimates cohort.

An honorarium of up to \$800 may be provided.
