Our browse program provides fresh tree trimmings and branches to support our Animal Nutrition and Animal Wellness programs. We collaborate with local partners—including tree care companies and municipalities—to source safe, high-quality browse for a variety of animal species.

Have a tree removal or site clearing project? We might be able to help! We are looking for chemically untreated, broad-leaved tree species with fresh foliage. Most of our animals prefer fresh product, but some actually prefer dried leaves. Our team will coordinate collection at no cost to you, making it easy to turn tree trimmings into a valuable resource for wildlife. Photos of trimmings are a quick and helpful way for us to assess their browse suitability.

We can also utilize larger limbs and logs for our elephants. These larger browse items play an important role in helping to maintain the dental health of our pachyderms.

With hundreds of plant species on our approved browse list, we welcome all opportunities and are happy to discuss any potential donations.
